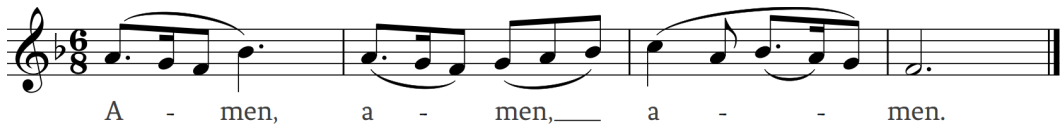
Holy God,
